General site information

- Make sure tents are at least six metres apart (approximately seven paces)
- Please be quiet, especially from 11pm-7am, and be considerate of other campers
- Help us keep the site clean by using the bins and recycling points provided
- Fires are only allowed if they are contained and raised off the ground
- Well behaved dogs on leads are welcome so long as they are cleared up after
- Parking on hard standing only

Shop and reception

Opening times vary depending on the season. For current opening times, please see the shop/reception door or the notices at the toilet blocks.

The shop sells a wide range of food, fresh pastries, hot drinks, confectionery, camping equipment, maps, etc.

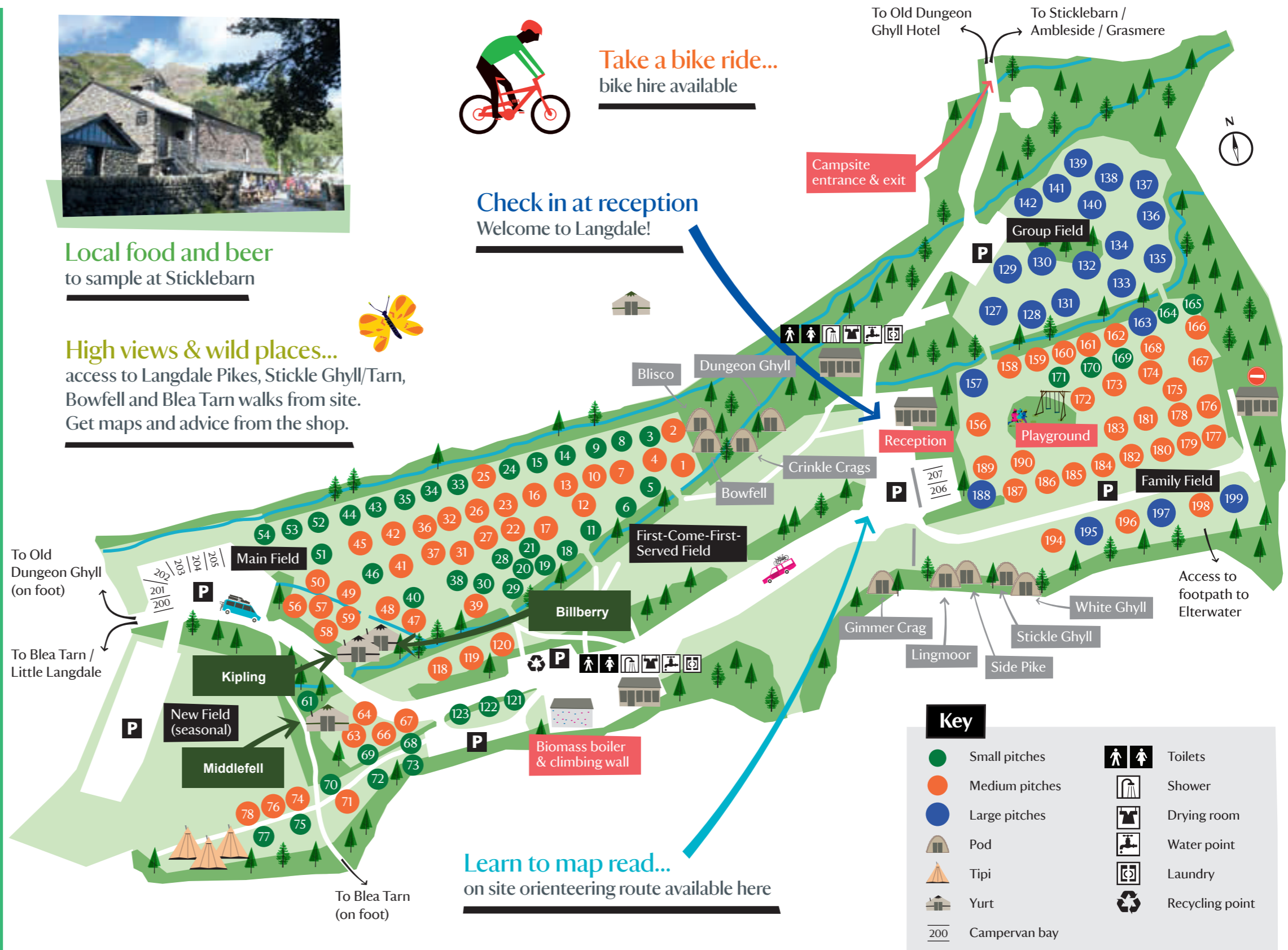
